Park Rules and Regulations

Dear Guests & Visitors,

Welcome to our Park!

Please read the following Park Rules and Regulations. These are to ensure that you and your neighbor will have an enjoyable stay with us. We will supply excellent service and quality camping facilities.

- **Registration:** All sites are assigned by the office. Person registering for site must be 18+ years of age and must have a credit card in order to hold the site. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. A Camping Unit consists of 6 People - Additional guests are \$3.00/night. Please note you are limited to 1 vehicle per campsite, there is a charge of \$5 a day for an extra vehicle parking permit at your campsite. Additional tents/units on site are \$15.00/night, \$30.00/night if units are sharing site's services. Check in time is between 2:00 pm and 10:00 pm. Check out time is 12:00 pm. 50% Deposits are required at booking. Payment in FULL is to be made at Check in. Late check outs, early check in requires management approval. Please keep all valuables in a safe place at night. Please keep your site clean, and use the recycling, and garbage bins provided at exit.

- **Visitors:** If you are expecting visitors, please discuss with the office staff. A free parking permit will be provided. Management reserves the right to limit the number of visitors per campsite. Please be advised we do not have a lot of visitor parking and we ask your guests do not park in un-rented sites. We hate to tow vehicles, but we will if necessary. ALL visitors may stay until 10:00pm. Bound to all park rules and may be asked to leave at any time.

- **Quiet Time:** 11:00pm to 07:00am. Please consider other campers always of the day. Car stereos must not be used. No generators allowed at any time. Drunkenness or noisy parties will not be tolerated at any time of the day.

Management has the authority to take any necessary action to ensure your safety, and of those around you. Anyone who is in breach of these regulations will be asked to leave the park and NO REFUND will be given.

- **Pets are Welcomed:** Pets must always be on a leash. Noisy or unattended pets are not tolerated; therefore, they and their masters will be asked to leave. Owners must clean up after their pets. Refuse bags are available at the office. Disposal is to be in the Dumpster by the exit. Please note, there will be a

\$25 clean up fee charged to your credit card if park staff must clean up after your pet's refuse, or damage from your pets, such as digging holes, or biting on tables etc.

- **Our Sites:** We offer 30 AMP services only. You can bring an adaptor for 15 AMP, but you cannot hook up to our outlets if you have 50 AMP (unless you have a Smart Management System), as it can damage our outlets and your units. If outlets are damaged, there will be a \$90.00 fee to replace the receptacle. If you are plugging into another unit's power, do so at your own risk. If too much power is drawn, it can cause electrical issues, and can possibly melt your plug and their outlet. Riverside Park is not responsible if this occurs. If our outlets are burnt, there will be a \$90.00 fee to replace the receptacle.

- **Campfires:** Please check with the office staff to see if there are any fire bans that may in effect. Firewood is available for purchase at the office by the bundle. Fires must not be left unattended. **CAMPFIRE SIZE** - A campfire is defined as a fire no larger than 0.5 metres high and 0.5 metres in diameter. Fires larger than that are considered Category 2 open fires and are illegal if Category 2 open burning prohibitions are in effect. Kindly extinguish all campfires before you retire for the night.

- **Picnic Table and Fire pit:** There is one picnic table and one fire ring at each site, and they should not be moved. If you move a table, it **MUST** be moved back or there is a \$25 fee. Fire pits **MUST NOT** be moved or there is a \$50.00 fee that will be charged.

- **Cigarette Smoking, Cannabis, Vaping and Alcohol:** Cigarette Smoking, Cannabis, Vaping and Alcohol is not permitted on the campground's common areas such as Group Kitchen, Washroom and Shower Facilities, Trails, Roads, etc. General rule of thumb is to keep your consumption to your own campsites. This goes without saying, but just in case – don't smoke and drive; don't drive high. Don't drink and drive; don't drive drunk. Safety first. There will be a \$25 site cleanliness fee charged for cigarette butts left at campsites or in fire pits.

- **Washrooms / Showers:** There are flush toilets and coin operated showers available. Showers accept tokens that may be purchased at the Office, with a \$1 token giving approximately 8 minutes of shower water. Small children should be accompanied by an adult. Please help us keep the washrooms clean by using the waste receptacles.

- **Security Gate:** Management reserves the right to lock the gates at 11:00pm – 07:00am. We are Starlight Drive –In www.starlightdrivein.ca friendly and like our guests to have respectful and responsible access to their Campsites. Please make special arrangements at the office with management. A free parking permit will be provided for parking access at the Lion's Gazebo upon your return.

- **Sani Dump:** Located at the front entrance. Guests dump for free. There is a \$5.00 fee to visitors. Free potable water is also supplied at front entrance.

- **Sewer:** YOU MUST USE A SEWER CONNECTOR. Please **DO NOT FLUSH** anything down the toilets, including toilets in your RV, except **RV TOILET PAPER**. It can block and back up! Do not put grease/cooking oil down your drains either as this will block the system. Please put grease in a container and put in the garbage bins. Service calls will be billed at \$90/hour.

- **Garbage / Recycling:** Please use the Garbage bins at the exit of the park or the garbage bins at multiple locations throughout the campground. Please do not encourage bottle collectors by giving away bottles. Rather leave your refundables in the designated bins for bottle returns, by the office and main dumpster area. There will be a \$25 site cleanliness fee charged for garbage left at campsites. This includes cigarette butts, on the grounds, or in the fire pits.

- Please observe and obey the posted 10km/hr speed limit signs throughout the park. **CHILDREN ARE PLAYING - GO SLOW!**

- Absolutely no fireworks at any time.
