



Rules and Policies

Please abide by the Rules and Policies. These are to ensure that everybody has an enjoyable stay.

- Check-in is 2:00pm Check-out is by 12:00pm.
- Early check-ins and late check-outs require advance approval.
- To book, you must be 18+ years of age. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Drive safe, the speed limit is 10km/hr.
- Park only at your site or in the designated visitor parking.
- Visitors may stay until 10:00pm and must abide by the Rules and Policies.
- Quiet Time is 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Car stereos, generators, loud dogs or other pets, and noisy parties are not allowed at any time of day. No drunk or disorderly behaviour. Smoking, vaping and alcohol are only permitted at your campsite if it does not create an unreasonable nuisance for others. No fireworks.
- Pets must be on a leash and not create a disturbance. Dogs that are dangerous or not socialized are prohibited. Pets must not be left unattended. Owners must clean up after their pets – “doggie bags” are available for free at the office.
- Please secure all items. Riverside Park will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Please keep your site clean during your stay and leave it clean upon your departure. Cigarette butts must be disposed of in a proper container, and not deposited on the grounds or in the fire pits. If you need a butt container, ask the office and one will be provided to you. Please do not move the picnic tables or firepits.
- Please use the designated garbage and recycling receptacles. If the items are too big to fit in the containers around the park, use the large dumpsters by the office. There is also additional recycling (plastic and cardboard) receptacles by the office.
- Campfire wood is available for purchase during office hours only. Campfires must not be left unattended and must be fully extinguished before going to bed or leaving your campsite. A campfire must not exceed 0.5 metres high and 0.5 metres in diameter. Please check with the office staff if there is a campfire ban.
- Showers accept tokens that may be purchased at the Office during office hours only.
- Entrance gate is locked from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Let the Office know in advance and a parking pass for the parking lot north of the Gazebo will be provided.
- Sani Dump and potable water are located at the entrance. Guests dump and fill for free.
- Sewer requires a sewer connector. Do not flush anything down the toilets except toilet paper or dump oil or grease down your drain.
- Power is only available for 30 AMP services or 15 AMP with an adaptor. 50 AMP service is not available. You can use an adaptor, but do not hook up unless you have a Smart Management System or you may damage the outlet or your unit.
- WiFi is available but password protected. Contact the Office to obtain the current password.
